The motivation letter should be written in clear and concise English. Please mention your name, education, department and instrument at the top.

Please describe why you want to study at the Prince Claus Conservatoire. Discuss the following issues:

- Why do you want to enter the Master of Music programme ? Where do you see yourself in 5 years' time? (indication: 100 words)
- Describe your general interest in the arts, sciences and culture. And your specific interest in styles, genres, other disciplines or new technology and how these musical experiences have led to your decision to enter the programme. (indication: 200 words)
- Why did you choose for the Prince Claus Conservatoire? What makes this conservatoire the preferred place of study for you? (indication: 100 words)
- Why do you think we should admit you, what special qualities do you bring to the course and what will you contribute to the course? (indication: 100 words)
- What do you intend or hope to be able to contribute yourself to the musical climate, both during the course as well as in the profession? You could think for example of previous experience with a specific music style, composers or with research (indication: 300 words)

Try to describe what moves you to make music and why you want to enter the Master's programme at the Prince Claus Conservatoire. The committee would like to get an impression of your motives to enter the Master's programme.
